KPI Tile 1: Contract Turnaround Time

Description: Measures the average time from the initial request for a contract review to the final execution of the agreement.

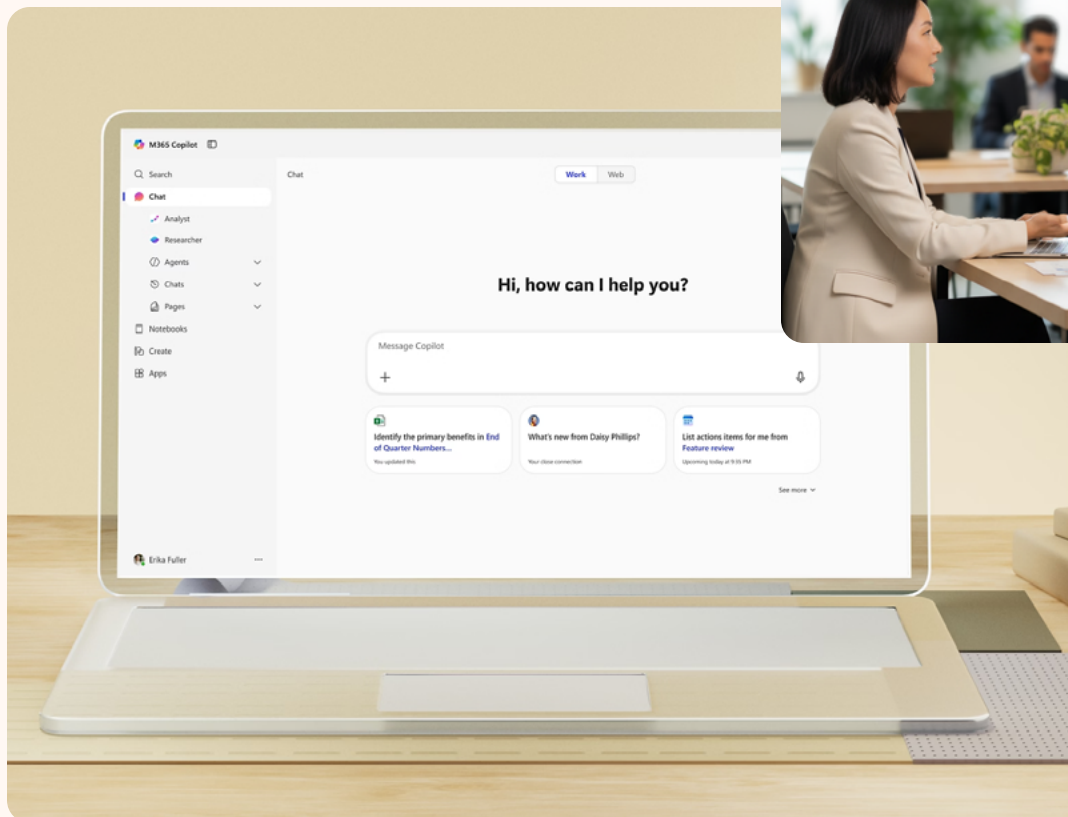

The Prompting Cheat Sheet: Mastering Your AI Assistant

Effective prompting is a structured conversation. To move from simple answers to strategic legal insights, all requests should be built on a foundation of clear principles. Use this cheat sheet as a framework for crafting prompts that deliver high-value results.

The Six Principles of Strategic Prompting

1. Assign a Role (The Persona)

Instruct the AI to adopt a specific persona. This frames the entire interaction. For example: "Act as a senior litigator" or "Write as a compliance officer reviewing for GDPR risks."

2. State Your Strategic Intent (The Goal)

Begin by clearly defining the legal objective. Don't just ask for a summary of a contract; ask for a summary *for the purpose of* identifying all indemnification clauses.

3. Provide Critical Context (The Why)

Explain the background. Is the output for an internal strategy session with senior counsel or for a client summary? Context transforms a generic request into a tailored one.

4. Ground Your Request in Data (The Source)

The most powerful AI responses are grounded in specific data. Reference contracts, case files, or regulatory documents using the / command (e.g., /MSA_Template_v3.docx).

5. Define the Desired Output (The Format)

Be explicit about the required structure. Specify the desired format (e.g., "a table comparing the two clauses", "a bulleted list of potential risks"), tone (e.g., "formal and direct", "advisory"), and length.

6. Iterate and Refine (The Conversation)

The first prompt is the start of a conversation. Use follow-up commands to refine the output. Ask the AI to "explain the legal precedent for this clause," or "rewrite this section to be clearer for a non-legal audience."

Exercise: Crafting a Contract Analysis Prompt

Let's get to work: Consider how you would delegate the task of performing an initial review of a third-party contract.

The Weak Prompt (Before):

"Review this contract."

This prompt is too vague and will produce a generic, high-level summary that misses critical details.

The Strategic Prompt (After):

"Act as a senior commercial counsel. (Persona) Analyze the attached vendor MSA /Vendor_MSA_Draft.docx. (Source) Create a table that compares the 'Limitation of Liability' and 'Data Privacy' clauses against our standard terms in /Our_MSA_Template.docx. (Intent & Format) For each deviation, provide a one-sentence summary of the associated risk. (Format)"

This strategic prompt delegates the creation of a specific, actionable risk-analysis document that an in-house counsel can use immediately for negotiation.

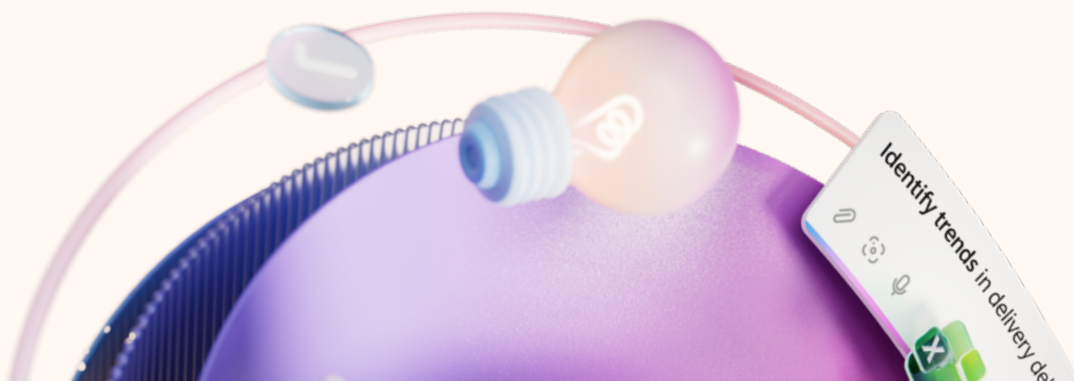

Your Move: Task your litigation team or paralegals with using this method to build their initial research memos.

Exercise: Creating Training Materials for New Legislation



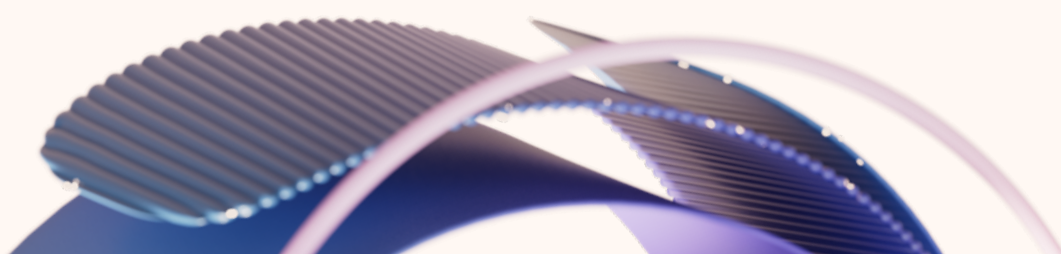
The Challenge: When new regulations are passed, the legal department must quickly create training materials to educate the business, a process that can take weeks of drafting and design.

The Value: Instantly generate a well-structured first draft of a PowerPoint presentation that explains complex new legislation in simple terms. Exercise: Analyzing and Optimizing Legal Costs

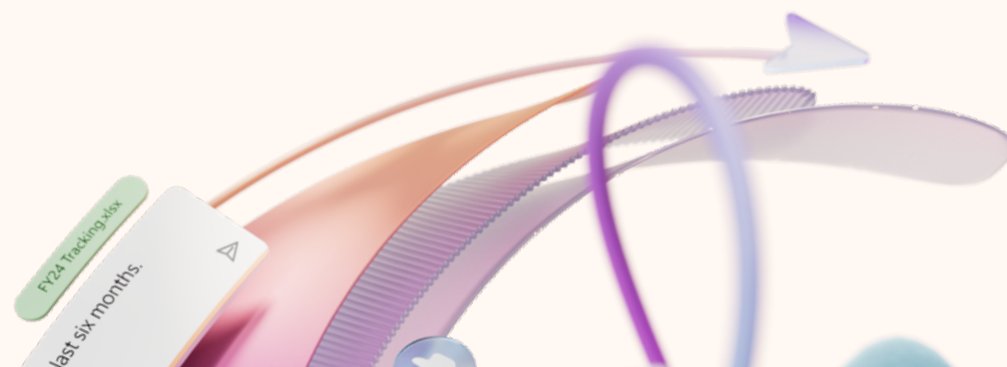

3. Set the recurrence for every Friday at 9:00 AM.

Your Move: Task your compliance team with setting up this automated brief to ensure consistent situational awareness.



Exercise (Agentic): Creating a "Standard Clause Check Agent" with a Saved Prompt



The Challenge: Before sending a standard agreement like an NDA to a third party, a lawyer has to manually check that all the latest approved legal language has been included.

The Value: Create a reusable *agent* that can be deployed instantly to validate any document against your approved template, ensuring compliance and consistency with zero manual review time.
